# THE WISSIONS

Its hard for me to believe that 2022 is already 1/3 over. Where has the time gone? When I think about the work of our association, the words of an old country song from Jerry Reed come rolling through my mind - "We've got a long way to go and a short time to get there." Those words ring true for me, and the church I pastor (and likely your church too), and for our association. Time is short!

We have a number of initiatives in the works to help your churches work on mission together here in our region. Each of these are supported by the PBA mission's statement: *Strengthening our churches to engage our communities with the gospel*.

- 1) Students In Transition | Our Mission Team will be organizing the collection of new and gently used clothing and toiletry items. These will be housed at association churches closest to each of the county's 20 schools. When a child is in need, the administration, counselors, nurses, and/or teachers will refer them to the closest "Students In Transition" closet. The closets will be stocked through the collective efforts of all of our churches. More details will be sent to your church in the coming weeks. We anticipate launching them for the start of this next school year.
- 2) Casino Conversations | Recently a group of pastors from across denominational lines discussed how our churches need to be prepared to minister to the growing needs of our city. Once the affects of gambling take root we will see a growing need for food, housing, and financial assistance. Join us for the second set of discussions on Tuesday, May 24th at Mt. Hermon Baptist Church (4385 Franklin Tpke). Lunch will be provided. 11:30am. I hope to see you there.
- 3) Revitalization Cohort | We will host a Church Revitalization Cohort at the PBA Office starting in October. We will meet the 3rd Thursday evening each month for 6-months (skipping December). Each session will include a session led by Dr. David Jackson, North American Mission Board's (NAMB) East Coast Revitalization Specialist, followed by a time of table and large group discussions. Our first meeting will be Thursday, October 20. Dinner will be provided. More details will be shared in the coming months.

Plan on attending our next **Executive Committee Meeting** on **May 17 @7pm**. Your input is vital to these projects and all we do as an association.
